We kindly ask that you provide two letters of recommendation as part of your application. One letter should come from a faculty member, while the other should be from a community member. These letters should address the following points:

- How the recommender knows you
- Notable accomplishments that left a positive impression on them
- Reasons why you are a strong candidate for this scholarship

Additionally, please include a copy of your high school transcript. Certification is not required for this document.

Furthermore, we request a typed, double-spaced paper ranging from one to three pages. In this essay, please express your passion for “the Arts” and articulate why your application deserves consideration for our scholarship. Be sure to cover:

- Personal interests and hobbies
- Your specific area of artistic expertise
- Your vision for utilizing your artistic skills in the future
- Any community service activities you are involved in

The Scholarship Committee is eager to review your letters and application materials. Please ensure that all questions are answered, all required documents are included, and that everything is presented neatly and legibly.
